

## Contractual Services Agreement

This agreement made at Salt Lake City, Kolkata on this 4th day of September 2022 between:

Pratham Education Foundation, a company registered under section 8 of the Companies Act 2013 with its office located in New Delhi, at B-4/58, 2nd Floor, Safdarjung Enclave, New Delhi- 110029 (hereinafter called "Pratham") of the one part, and

Rintu Kumar Biswas(hereinafter called "Second Party"),having PAN: AGWPB8539R with his addressat C/O Sachindra Nath Biswas, Suryasen Colony, Block No.C, Siliguri Town, Jalpaiguri of the other part and collectively known as "Parties".

AND WHEREAS Rintu Kumar Biswaswill conduct activities related to the Annual Status of Education Report (ASER) 2022in Birbhum district,West Bengal State from 5th September 2022 to 20th September 2022 using their own manpower and handover the collected data to Pratham and in return Pratham has agreed to provide contractual fees of Rs.71725/- (Rupees Seventy-one thousand seven hundred twenty five

only), inclusive of all applicable statutory taxes, to undertake and complete the surveyon its behalfon the following terms and conditions:

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH and it is mutually agreed upon by and between the parties hereto under:

Pratham and Rintu Kumar Biswas hereby mutually agree and declare as under:

### BASIC UNDERSTANDING

- A. Pratham and Rintu Kumar Biswasmutually acknowledge the legal autonomy of each other, registered as they are under their respective laws;
- B. ASER Centre is a research wing of Pratham.
- C. Both parties are mutually willing to define and identify their respective responsibilities and liabilities, through the instrument of this Agreement and fully abide by the terms and conditions agreed to;
- D. It is understood and agreed that the basic purpose of entering into this Agreement is to complete ASER 2022by Rintu Kumar Biswas.If, for any reason, it is later found that this purpose is not being realized, then Pratham would be at liberty to terminate the agreement after giving 2 weeks written notice of the same. Detailed list of "Deliverable for both the parties" is being attached with this contract as "Annexure 1".
- E. It is understood and accepted that Pratham and Rintu Kumar Biswaswill work with families & communities to achieve the desired objective in the selected geographical area.
- F. Since Rintu Kumar Biswasor its employees/workers/representatives are required to interact with the children, a Child Protection Declaration is to be taken from every employees/workers/representativeswho will be directly involved with the children being surveyed Rintu Kumar Biswaswill ensure that the declaration is taken and provided to Pratham before start of the survey. Child Protection Declaration format is attached as "Annexure 2" with this contract.

G. Rintu Kumar Biswas shall not without the prior written approval of Pratham:

1. Change the location, area or scale of the survey.
2. Further sub-contract the work as specified in this agreement to any organization or individual.

H. Pratham shall provide contractual fees for the said project undertaken by Rintu Kumar Biswas per the following schedule and TDS will be deducted @ 1% for which Pratham will provide Form 16A after completion of the quarter. Rintu Kumar Biswas will furnish copy of its PAN card to Pratham. In the case where PAN card is not furnished by Rintu Kumar Biswas then TDS will be deducted @ 20% and no Form 16A will be provided.

- I. Rintu Kumar Biswas shall submit ASER 2022 (Child undertaking declaration, survey booklets, finance formats) deliverables of ASER 2022 by 20<sup>th</sup> September 2022.
- J. It should be the responsibility of Rintu Kumar Biswas to meet out, deduct and pay all statutory levies and taxes, if any, whenever necessary and to comply with all legal requirements in connection with this contract. Rintu Kumar Biswas shall indemnify and keep Pratham indemnified against all losses and damages arising from any neglect or delay by Rintu Kumar Biswas in complying with its obligations in the foregoing circumstances.
- K. The completion of the deliverables of the survey shall entirely be the responsibility of Rintu Kumar Biswas.
- L. If at any stage it is found and proved that Rintu Kumar Biswas is not complying with the conditions given in this agreement; Pratham may terminate this agreement by giving 2 weeks written notice to Rintu Kumar Biswas.
- M. Pratham retains the right to recover from Rintu Kumar Biswas an amount equivalent to all disallowed expenses resulting from any audits carried out during or after the period of the Agreement.

## Annexure 1

### PART I: RESPONSIBILITIES OF Rintu Kumar Biswas

#### A. RESPONSIBILITIES OF Rintu Kumar Biswas:

- Assign 1 contact person to coordinate the training of volunteers and support ASER Centre in completing the survey satisfactorily in the district.
- Identify volunteers to conduct the survey in 30 villages; 2 volunteers will conduct the survey in 1 village.
- Facilitate and arrange training over a period of at least 3 days.
- Ensure that all volunteers attend all days of training. If a volunteer's performance in the classroom and during field work is found to be dissatisfactory, the Rintu Kumar Biswas will be asked to replace the volunteer.
- Ensure that the volunteers visit the 30 villages and conduct the survey over a period of 2 days (Saturday and Sunday, or Sunday and Monday) as per the procedure specified by Pratham (ASER Centre).
- Take responsibility to ensure that all volunteers follow the survey procedures and rules.
- Take responsibility to ensure that all volunteers and other representatives of the Rintu Kumar Biswas have been made aware of the contents of the Child Protection Declaration.
- Ensure timely submission of all survey-related data and financial formats to Pratham (ASER Centre) staff as per the instructions outlined in the agreement, survey and financial pack.
- Ensure that all volunteers are reimbursed for survey-related costs.
- If survey or data from a particular village(s) is found to be of poor quality, then that village will have to be resurveyed by the Rintu Kumar Biswas at no additional cost to Pratham (ASER Centre).
- Complete honesty and integrity is expected from the Rintu Kumar Biswas and the volunteers provided by the Rintu Kumar Biswas, during survey.
- If there are any difficulties in getting the tasks completed, the difficulties must be shared with the Pratham (ASER Centre) team in writing.
- Rintu Kumar Biswas must ensure that the names of the surveyed village are not shared with anybody other than the volunteers who will go for the survey. It is a usual practice in research projects to keep names of villages and households confidential to protect the privacy of respondents.

#### B. RESPONSIBILITIES OF EACH VOLUNTEER:

- Attend all days and all sessions of the training.
- Be punctual and participate sincerely in the classroom sessions and field work during the training. If a volunteer's performance in the classroom and during field work is found to be unsatisfactory, the Rintu Kumar Biswas will be asked to replace the volunteer.
- During the survey, a volunteer must:
  - Visit the assigned village with an assigned Rintu Kumar Biswas volunteer and collect information as per Pratham (ASER Centre) guidelines, procedures and rules.
  - Select households in the village using the specified procedure.
  - Survey and test children in each of these households as per Pratham (ASER Centre) guidelines. Fill out all required formats carefully, legibly and accurately.
  - Conduct the survey over a period of 2 days (Saturday and Sunday, or Sunday and Monday).



- Conduct the survey with complete integrity and honesty.
- Be polite and respectful to the children, families and other villagers in the village.
- Share any difficulties faced during the survey with the Pratham (ASER Centre) staff.
- Not share/reveal the names of the surveyed village /village list or surveyed children with anyone.
- Submit the completed formats and survey booklets immediately after the completion of survey to the Pratham (ASER Centre) staff.

**PART II: RESPONSIBILITIES OF PRATHAM (ASER CENTRE)**

- Conduct training for all volunteers for at least 3 days in the district and bear costs of the training. During training, Pratham (ASER Centre) staff will decide whether the volunteers provided by the Rintu Kumar Biswas qualify to do the survey.
- Bear the cost of food incurred by participants during the training and field work as per the rates and procedures as agreed upon in advance between the Rintu Kumar Biswas and Pratham (ASER Centre).
- Bear survey-related material and logistics cost as agreed upon in advance between the Rintu Kumar Biswas and Pratham (ASER Centre).
- Closely monitor and recheck the survey in the district.
- Ensure payment is made to the Rintu Kumar Biswas as per agreed terms.
- Acknowledge the Rintu Kumar Biswas in the Annual Status of Education Report 2022.
- Share a copy of the ASER 2022 report with the Rintu Kumar Biswas.

Under this programme, we identify driven and motivated students through partnerships with colleges and universities and provide them with the training they need to design and implement solutions for a specific environmental challenge. The theme for the Echo programme is aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and focuses on most pressing environmental issue of the year.

At the end of the academic year, projects are reviewed and evaluated against set parameter in a state elimination round and selected colleges are provided a chance to showcase their projects at the national level summit. A panel of jury reviews the projects, which are presented by student representatives, and the college with maximum impact is recognized with the title of "Environment Conservation Hero of the Year".

### **THE ACTIVITY**

WWF-India in partnership with the registered college will launch Echo for engagement of students enrolled in the college, through a year-long membership for the students. Each college will nominate one teacher convenor and four youth representatives to lead and represent the respective college in Echo. At the beginning of the academic year, a workshop for the nominated youth representatives and teacher convener will be organized for all participating colleges.
